Sub: Reservation – Block Reservation for bonafied passengers Traveling in Group such as Marriage Parties, Cultural Groups, etc.

Railway Board vide letter No.95/TG-U/20/P dated 08.09.05, has permitted the maximum number of seats/berths allowed to be applied for on one reservation requisition slip is six, whether it is family or a group.

Railway Board has also allowed zonal Railways to permit bonafied parties traveling in group consisting more than 6 viz., for the purpose of marriage, cultural, sport, education, pilgrim purpose to secure reservation against a singly reservation form.

Railway Board vide their letter No.98/TG-1/20/P dated 17.02.99 has permitted the zonal Railways to lay down guidelines and delegate powers at various levels to permit such group booking.

Group booking will henceforth be allowed in all trains on SECR subject to the provisions mentioned below :-

General Conditions:

- 1. Group booking will be permitted to bonafied passengers traveling in Group viz., Marriage Parties, Students, Pilgrims, Sports, Cultural Troops etc.
- 2. There is no restriction for group booking on opening day of reservation
- 3. At any time group booking permission may not be granted for more than 50% of the berths available.
- 4. The names, age, sex and address of all the members of the group are furnished at the time of seeking permission.
- Persons applying for group booking should apply directly to the competent authority and not through travel agents.
- Special care should be taken to restrict group booking during festival season and summer rush so that general public will not be inconvenienced.
- 7. While permitting group booking in slip coaches care may be taken to avoid blocking of berths enmass and permission should be restricted.
